#### ORDER

On June 1, 2007, the Court vacated the original judgment, entered on April 27, 2007, and remitted the judgment to the following: \$10,000 in compensatory damages to Gloria Bohan, \$10,000 in compensatory damages to Omega World Travel, Inc., and \$10,000 in compensatory damages to Cruise.com, Inc., to be paid by the defendants jointly and severally; and \$100,000 in punitive damages to Gloria Bohan, \$100,000 in punitive damages to Omega World Travel, Inc., and \$100,000 in punitive damages to Cruise.com, Inc., to be paid by the defendants jointly and severally. The Court stayed the entry of the remitted judgment for thirty (30) days to allow the plaintiffs to decide whether they would accept the remitted judgment or seek a new trial. On June 29, 2007, the plaintiffs submitted their Acceptance of Remitted Judgment. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Clerk enter judgment in favor of the plaintiffs against the defendants in the above-referenced
