## <u>Order</u>

Before the court is the report and recommendation (Doc. 16) of Magistrate

Judge Thomas M. Blewitt, proposing that the court deny defendants' motion to

dismiss the instant complaint. No objections to the report and recommendation have

been filed, and the time for such filing has passed. Therefore, in order to decide

whether to adopt the report and recommendation, the court must determine whether

a review of the record evidences plain error or manifest injustice. See, e.g., Sullivan

v. Cuyler, 723 F.2d 1077, 1085 (3d Cir. 1983); FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b) 1983 Advisory

Committee Notes ("When no timely objection is filed, the court need only satisfy itself
that there is no clear error on the face of the record to accept the recommendation");

28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1).

After a careful review, the court finds neither a clear error on the face of the record nor a manifest injustice, and therefore the court shall adopt the report and

recommendation. Accordingly:
