**TENTATIVE RULING**

The motion to dismiss for failure to prosecute (CCP 583.310 [Code Civil Procedure section 583.310 requires that "An action shall be brought to trial within five years after the action is commenced against the defendant."]) and CCP 583.410 [Dismiss for Delay in Prosecution] is dropped. On June 30, 2011, Judge Burger-Plavan ordered all proceedings in this action stayed to December 11, 2011.

**COURT RULING**

The Court affirmed the tentative ruling.
