## Disruption of School Environment

He went on to post these pictures on his fine book web page and send it to other students. Imput admitted to doing this and provided us with copies of the postings. A meeting with the base his parents and Dr. Mehrotra took place on 12/07/07 to help the new understand the seriousness of invading a teacher's privacy. It was also to help everyone involved know that any future infraction of this nature would result in 10 days OSS with referral to the superintendent's office.

Future behaviors of this type will result in referral to the superintendent's office for additional consequences.

This action is a violation of Rockwood School District policy as outlined in the booklet "2007-2008 Policies, Regulations, Procedures and Consequences pertaining to Middle and High School Students" Regulation 2610.

As a result of this hearing, the above named student is suspended for 3 school days. The suspension begins on December 10, 2007. The student may return to school December 13, 2007.

- 1. You are to discuss the circumstances of your suspension with your parents as soon as possible. If your parent was unavailable to discuss your suspension with me, ask him/her to telephone me at their earliest convenience.
- 2. You are not to be on the school grounds of any Rockwood school, including the parking lots, while under suspension without prior written approval from this office. Suspension from school excludes students from participation and attendance in or at any athletic or school activity either at home or away. Failure to follow this rule will result in additional suspension days.
- 3. Students may make up work for credit for the first out-of-school suspension. On the second out-of-school suspension and each one thereafter, students may do the work but will not receive credit except for exams and major projects. Superintendent suspensions out-of-school do not allow for any credit during the time of the suspension.
